## WEDNESDAY FEBRUARY 22

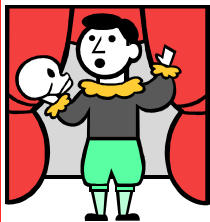

## THURSDAY FEBRUARY 23

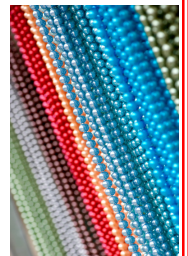
