



## Early Childhood LITERACY

### 12 - Week Session for Ages 4-6

Children will learn literacy skills through poems, songs and reinforcement activities. This course is designed to get readers and non-readers engaged in reading and writing. Children who are re-registering will continue to gain valuable skills in rhyme, vocabulary and expanded reading ability.

The curriculum was created at the prestigious Bank Street College of Education in New York. It is taught by certified Rhode Island teachers with Masters degrees in Early Childhood and Literacy. **9 - 11 AM or 1- 3 PM**

## Early Childhood SPANISH FOR FUN!

### 10 - Week Session for Ages 3-5

**Mondays: Sept. 26 - Dec. 5**

Learn Spanish together! You and your child will learn words and songs in Spanish. Parent/guardian will join the children so the whole family can participate. Lessons are geared for children ages 3-5, but other young children are welcome. Register by 9/12

## Early Childhood NUMBER SENSE

### 10- Week Session for Ages 4-6

**Fridays: Sept. 30 - Dec. 16** (no class 11/11 & 25)

Children will learn math concepts through songs, hands-on activities, and everyday math related experiences. This course will focus on the concept of "number" (counting, determining relative quantities, less and more), and basic operations such as adding and subtracting.

### 12 - Week Session for Ages 0-4

**Wednesdays: Sept. 28 - Dec. 14**

Accompanied by a parent/guardian the children will explore musical development. Activities will include vocal play, sounds, rhythm, language and genuine silly fun while learning tonality and more. Educational Tips and Curriculum Concepts will be shared with the participating adult.

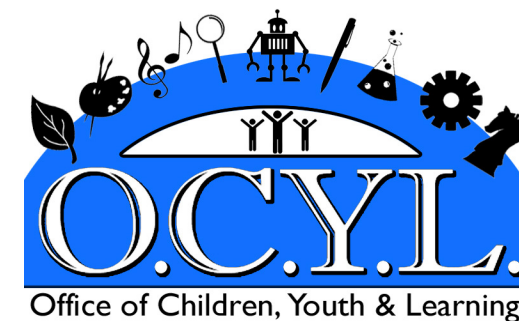
### Refund Policy Class Updates:
